Brightmail [Close](#)

Passed

This is the Symantec Brightmail Message Filter (formerly Brightmail AntiSpam). It's a server-side spam filter that blocks mail before it enters the network.



MessageLabs [Close](#)

Passed with a score of 3.4

MessageLabs is an expensive corporate server-side spam filter. It is in use by many large organisations and is very regularly updated.



Postini [Close](#)

Passed

Postini is another server-side spam filter, now owned by Google. Like MessageLabs it is in use mainly by large organisations.



Outlook 2003 [Close](#)

Passed

The built-in junk e-mail filter for Outlook 2003, which ships as part of Microsoft Office. This has various sensitivity settings, here we have set it to 'High'.



Outlook 2007 [Close](#)

The built-in junk e-mail filter for Outlook 2007, which ships as part of Microsoft Office. This has various sensitivity settings, here we have set it to 'High'.



Gmail [Close](#)

The filter offered as part of Google's Gmail service. Recipients can aid delivery by adding the sender's email address to their address book. That's not been done here, so this represents a more pessimistic spam scoring.
